Guidelines for Authors / Contributors

1. Title of the case: “Separation of the role of Chairman and CEO: Does it improve Corporate Governance”
2. The Author’s name, contact details shall be mentioned on first page below the title.
3. Each case should start with a brief abstract of about 150 to 200 words
4. The case length may be up to maximum 2500 words only.
5. The case should be typed in MS Word Doc, Times New Roman, 12 point, Double-spaced.
6. List the most relevant sources and make sure that the references confirm to standard editorial style and be written last. Use APA style of referencing.
7. The case should start with an introduction and end with a conclusion summarizing the findings of the case, preferably. Conclusions should briefly answer the objectives of the study.

Note:

1. This contest is only for students.
2. There is no Registration fees.
3. Each shortlisted participant will be given a “Certificate of Participation”.
4. Case shall be submitted on or before 10th January’ 18.
5. Power point presentation: 5-15 slides for final presentation, if shortlisted.
6. Presentation time will be 15 minutes followed by 5 minutes questions and answers.
7. Any number of students can participate from one institute but individually and/or maximum in a group of 3 students.
